In collaboration with Te Awhina Cameron Community House, He Kahui Wairarapa and Connecting Communities Wairarapa Youth Development the Eastside Community Group was connected and responded to their communities needs during the national lockdown.



Collectively these groups worked together to support over 115 households access essential supplies.

Eastside is a connected community and knowing our people made it easy to identify our vulnerable and those that needed support to make sure they the had essentials their whānau needed during the national lockdown. Individual letters were sent out to kaumatua and a community survey and newsletter were distributed on social media and hardcopies to letterboxes to ensure everyone had a opportunity to voice their opinions on needs they see for their community, ideas and a chance to ask for support and stay connected with what was happening in their community.
