



A preview of the questions asked in the request form. Applications must be made through the online grants system [Logging into the grants management system](#)

Main questions

- **What do you want funding for?**
Prompt: Describe what operating costs, projects or activities will you be using the funding for.
Recommended length: One paragraph.
- **Select the committee you are applying to**
- **Is this request for the purchase of a new building, new facility, or renovation of existing facility?**
- **What are the outcomes your mahi (activities / project) is aiming to achieve?**
Recommended length: One or two paragraphs.
- **Who will benefit the most from your mahi?**
Example: We provide support and benefits for young people with autism and their families.
Note: If applicable, name any specific hapū or iwi which will benefit.
Recommended length: One or two sentences.
- **How are community, hapū or iwi involved in your project?**
Prompt: What engagement, collaboration or consultation has there been with the wider community? What ongoing involvement will there be?
Recommended length: One or two paragraphs.
- **Where will your mahi provide the most benefit?**
Prompt: Provide details about the location(s) which will benefit most from your work, such as townships, suburbs, rural areas, etc.
Example: We support people in the Whakatāne district, with outreach efforts to our smaller rural communities of Te Teko, Edgecumbe, Taneātua, Ruatoki and Waimana.
Recommended length: One or two sentences.
- **How many years are you requesting funding for?**
- **What is the amount you are requesting per year?**
